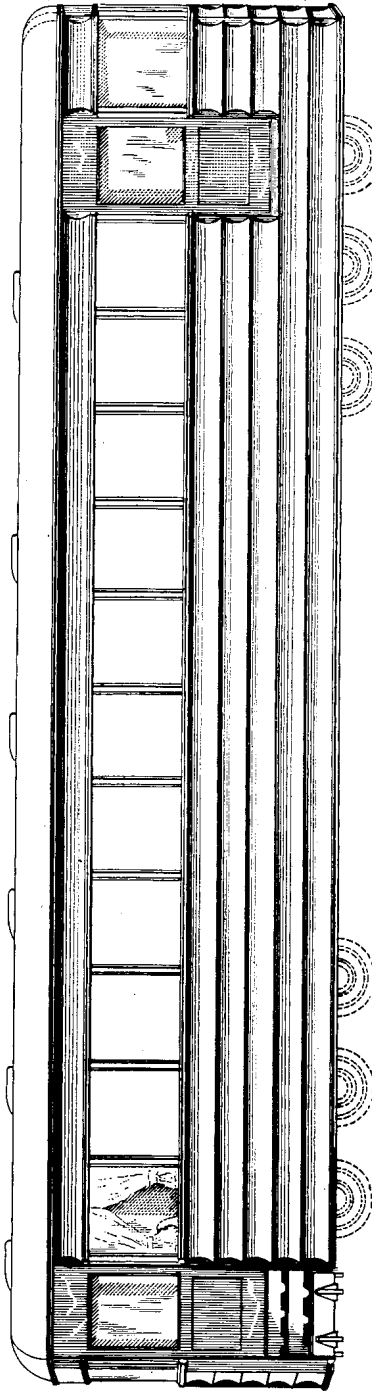

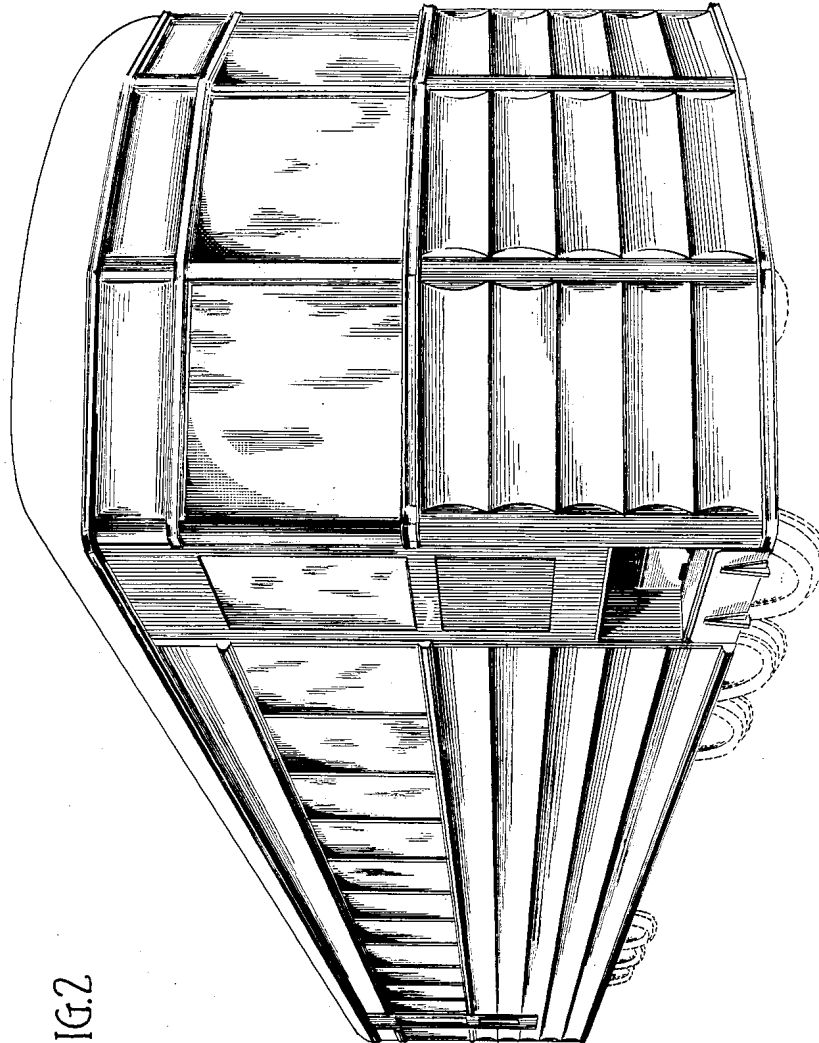

### DESIGN FOR A RAIL CAR

Application filed April 23, 1932. Serial No. 43,589. Term of patent 14 years.

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, EARL J. W. RAGSDALE, a citizen of the United States, residing at Norristown, in the county of Montgomery and State of Pennsylvania, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Rail Car, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, which form a part hereof.

Fig. 1 is a side elevational view of a rail car showing my new design.

Fig. 2 is a three-quarter perspective view. I claim:

The ornamental design for a rail car substantially as shown.
